at Jones, wherein an unknown number of those bullets, struck and entered Jones' body. These shots fired by SDPD OFFICER SCOTT THOMPSON and SDPD OFFICER GREGORY LINDSTROM caused the injury and death of Jones. Said shooting, claimant herein asserts, was excessive, unreasonable and a violation of Jones' rights. SDPD OFFICER SCOTT THOMPSON and SDPD OFFICER GREGORY LINDSTROM and Does 1 -10 committed these violations, and of the below listed contentions while acting within the course and scope of their employment pursuant to Cal. Gov't Code § 815.2.
